## NOTES

Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner daily - Meals other than the closing banquet on Wednesday night are not included in the registration fee. There will be a full breakfast buffet each morning (Monday - Wednesday) in the hotel restaurant, Bobby Bahia's Caribbean Grille, and this is included in the cost of your room. As a convenience to our conference attendees, there will also be a daily lunch buffet, again in the hotel restaurant, for \$15 per person. In addition to the lunch buffet, the hotel will offer a 20% discount off of the restaurant dining room a la carte lunch menu. Dinner is also served from 5:00 pm - 1:00 AM at Bobby Bahia's. The hotel offers a Complimentary Scheduled Shuttle service within a 5-mile radius of the hotel, if you prefer to eat at one of the many local restaurants. It runs from 7:30 AM -10:00 PM daily.

Airport pickup and return – The Double Tree Hilton does not operate an airport shuttle directly from the hotel. They recommend Alphatrans. The charge from the Fort Lauderdale airport to the hotel is \$60; from the Palm Beach airport it is \$75, and from the Miami airport to the hotel would be \$105. It's a lot, we know, but it's still less expensive than taking a taxi. You will need to make a reservation for the service, and they advise making those arrangements sooner than later. Sightseeing – What an ideal convergence: our hotel is only three miles from a world-class beach AND there's a free hotel shuttle that covers a 5-mile radius! How could it be any more convenient? And the beach isn't all this area offers—there are a number of other opportunities for sightseeing and shopping in the vicinity. **Transportation around town** – Like we said above, the hotel offers a Complimentary Scheduled Shuttle service within a 5-mile radius of the hotel. This runs from 7:30 AM – 10:00 PM daily. There are also cab and limousine services outside of the 5-mile radius. The hotel staff will be glad to assist you in arranging for transportation.
