NOTES

Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner Daily — Meals other than the closing banquet on Wednesday night are not included in the registration fee. In the mornings, most of the area hotels have either a breakfast buffet or a restaurant on site for your convenience. Breakfast will also be available in the Wheaton College cafeteria, from 7:15 – 10:00. Lunch will be served daily, also in the Wheaton College cafeteria, where a section of tables will be reserved

for our group. Dinner will be on your own Monday and Tuesday, and there is a wide variety of restaurants to choose from within a reasonable distance of the campus. When walking off campus after dark, however, we suggest that you walk in groups to provide maximum security. (We would offer the same advice for anyone walking after dark in an urban area.) Many of our folks will have vehicles, so don't be shy—ask for a ride if you're heading to a common destination.

Airport Pickup and Return — Transportation from and back to the airports (O'Hare and Midway) is available via two services recommended by our friends at Wheaton College. The first is West Suburban Travelers, which provides transportation from O'Hare airport to the Naperville area for \$49.00 (from Midway the rate is \$58.00).
