NOTES

Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner daily —

Meals other than the closing banquet on Wednesday night are not included in the registration fee. The hotel has a restaurant on-site that is open for breakfast, lunch, and dinner. There are numerous restaurants within walking distance of the hotel, with a wide variety of food choices.

Transportation from the airport —

The hotel does not provide airport shuttle services. There is a rapid transportation system called the Canada Line that departs every 7 minutes from the airport every day from 5:10 AM to 12:57 AM. It takes approximately 25 minutes to reach the downtown core, and costs \$9 CAD per person. The closest stop to the hotel is Vancouver City Centre, which is 5 ½ blocks from the hotel. (More information is available on the www.lcje-na.org website). Taxicabs are readily available from the airport, and will cost \$31.00 CAD to the hotel. It is about a 30minute ride from the airport to the hotel. Popular ride-sharing services like Uber and Lyft aren't yet available in Vancouver due to opposition from the taxi industry.
