Hotel Info — The DoubleTree by Hilton Anaheim-Orange County is located at 100 The City Drive, Orange, CA, 92868. Detailed information about the hotel and the local area is available on their website ([click here](#)) or call (714) 634-4500.

Meals other than the closing banquet on Wednesday evening are not included in your conference registration. The hotel has a restaurant on site, the Trofi Restaurant & Bar, which is open for breakfast, lunch, and dinner. A word about LCJE — The 1980 Lausanne Consultation on World Evangelization (LCWE) met in Pattaya, Thailand. One of its 17 mini-consultation groups was on “Reaching Jews”—and that was the genesis of LCJE. So, LCJE is the arm of the Lausanne movement that focuses on reaching Jewish people worldwide with the Good News of Yeshua the Messiah. The broader Lausanne movement unites Bible believers around the Lausanne Covenant, formulated by the late evangelical Anglican theologian John Stott.
